Scholarship Criteria

The American Legion is dedicated to helping Veterans and their families. To that end, Unknown Soldier Post #137 is committed to assisting our graduating seniors towards a rewarding work experience by offering our Scholarship assistance to those showing a commitment to a future career requiring technical training.

Applicant Criteria – Unknown Soldier Post #137 Scholarship is open to a graduating senior from McIntosh Academy. The student must attend a technical institute in a program designed to lead to a diploma. The recipient must have been a resident in McIntosh County for at least two (2) years.

Educational Criteria – Unknown Soldier Post #137 Scholarship may be applied to acceptance into a technical or vocational training program. A minimum "C" average is required for application.

Selection Process and Criteria – Unknown Soldier Post #137 Scholarship will follow the following process:

- Applicants should complete the application and submit it to the McIntosh Academy Guidance office by April 15, 2024.
- Applications shall be thoroughly reviewed by the Scholarship Committee; and, they will make recommendations to the Executive Board for approval.
- Applicant may be selected for a personal interview.
- Scholarship Awards will be sent to the technical or vocational school which the recipient is planning to attend.
- Criteria will also include weighing financial need.
- This is an Equal Opportunity process and will not be judged on race, sex, color, creed or physical limitations.
- All decisions are final.

Scholarship Amount - Award will be made in amount from \$500 to \$1,500 depending upon the fund balance.
